Installing Rustdesk

Imagatec use's Rustdesk's robust framework to access stores locally, allowing for Imagatec to provide remote support. The steps provided below show all the steps prior to Imagatec finalising the set-up. If you have any issues along the way, please call into Imagatec for assistance.

1. Installing Rustdesk via a link.

2. Opening and Installing Rustdesk
