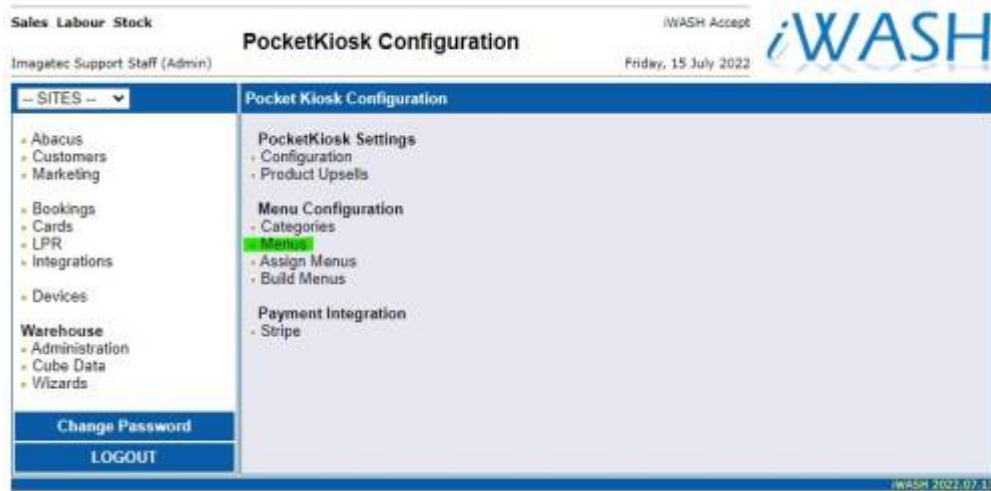


PocketKiosk Menus

Configuring the menus

1. Go to the menus link to configure the menu



2. If you have not created any menus yet, one will be created for you.

 1. The Menu Name is used for display purposes when assigning them to the sites using the kiosk, so ensure that it is relevant
 2. Choose the Categories you want to show on the menu, and drag and drop them in the order that you wish for them to show in
4. Press Save when complete

Assigning the menus to the sites

1. Open the Assign menus link to start assigning sites,



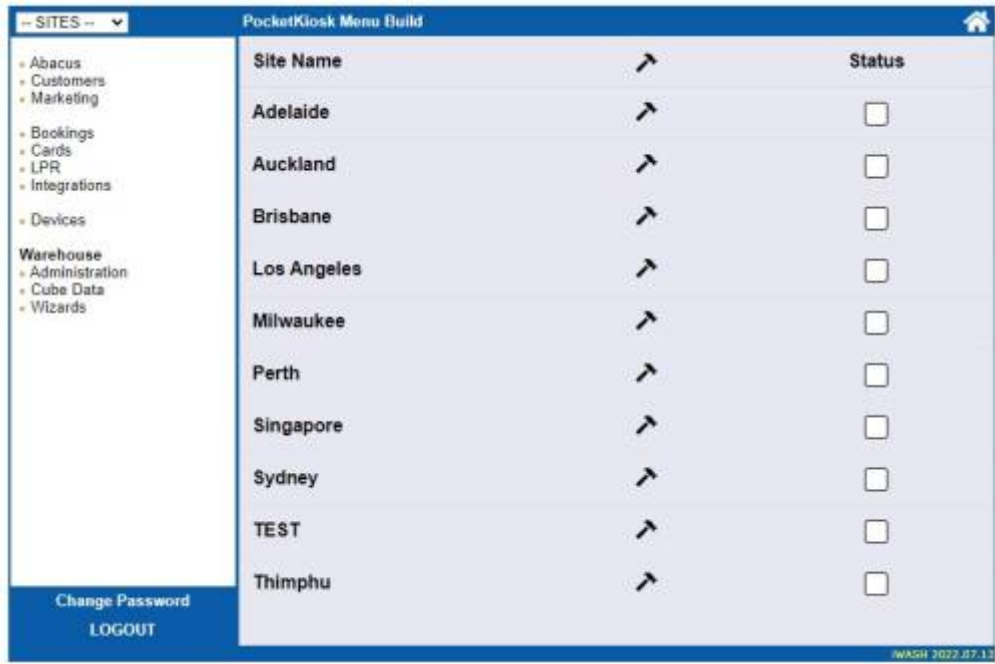
